Camp Fees

The weekly Great Escape fee is \$120 for the first child and \$100 per week for each additional child from a family. The daily Great Escape rate is \$28 per day for the first child and \$24 per day for each additional child from a family. Great Escape half day fees are \$22 per half day for the first child and \$18 per half day for each additional child. Super Ts are \$36 per day for the first child and \$32 per day for each additional child from a family. The weekly Super T fee is \$160 for the first child and \$140 per week for each additional child from a family. No half days available for Super Ts. Registration

Pre-registration is required for all campers. Registration can be made at the Harderwyk office during business hours, through the mail, or at the June 10th open house. Advanced reservations for the summer are recommended to guarantee space for your child/children. Camp does fill up. Cancellation of advanced reservations is required for all campers by the Thursday prior to the week of attendance. Payment will be expected if reservations are not canceled, whether or not your child attends.

Payments

To register your child for the summer, a one time \$10.00 per camper registration fee and payment for your child's first week of camp must accompany this application. This confirms your space on the summer calendar. Advance payments are not refundable. During the summer, payment or cancellation is due for all reservations the Thursday prior to the week of attendance. For example, you must make payment or cancel your reservation by Thursday, June 17 for campers attending the week of June 21. Payment is required for all reservations that have not been cancelled by this date. There are no refunds, make ups or credits for changes made after this date. Advance payment is required for all campers. Please make all checks payable to Neighbors Plus with the name and dates of the camper attending on your check. Clearly mark cash payments in an envelope with the child's name, the camp dates and the amount of cash enclosed. A \$15 service fee will be charged for checks returned for insufficient funds. **LATE PICK-UPS:** After 6 p.m., an overtime rate of \$5 per five minutes will be billed. After 15 minutes a \$20 fee will be charged and will double with every 15 minute increment. Arrangements may be made for emergencies if prior notice is given to the camp director.
