

Great Escape Assistant Camp Counselor Job Description

<u>Goal</u>: To assist camp counselors in planning and implementing summer activities for school-aged children which encourage the Great Escape goals of spiritual growth, peer relationship building, physical activity, and creative development.

Responsibilities:

- Assist camp counselors with daily activities, games, sports, projects and outings, within your age group.
- 2. Establish personal relationships with the Great Escape participants, particularly with children needing extra support, while being a leader.
- 3. Demonstrate faith in action at all times.
- 4. Be respectful and help maintain the respectful conduct of all participants at Great Escape.
- 5. Be attentive to the safety of all Great Escape participants at all times.
- 6. Assist your team as needed.

Job Requirements:

- 1. Personable with a love for children and inventive play.
- 2. Experience and ability to develop relationships with children.
- 3. Ability to be a leader of children.
- 4. Ability to share faith lessons in daily activities.
- 5. Must be going into Junior year of high school for 2020-2021 school year or older.
