

Great Escape Camp Counselor Job Description

Goal: To be a leader of summer activities for school-aged children (pre K-7th grade), which encourages the Great Escape goals of faith development, peer relationship building, physical activity, and creativity.

Job Requirements:

1. Personable, with a heart for children.
2. Ability to be a leader of children.
3. Interested in the intellectual development of children and use of creative learning opportunities.
4. Currently hold or be willing to attain CPR certification.
5. Have a valid driver's license with no tickets or at fault accidents/moving violations in the last 6 months.
6. Have completed one year of college, by the start of camp.

Responsibilities:

1. Lead devotions, Bible lessons, and faith building activities, as part of a leadership team.
2. Plan and lead daily recreational activities, games, sports, crafts, service projects, and outings, as a part of a leadership team.
3. Establish personal relationships with the Great Escape participants, particularly with children needing extra support.
4. Demonstrate faith in action to campers, staff and parents.
5. Maintain respectful conduct of all Great Escape participants.
6. Be a team player, assisting and supporting others on staff.
7. Be attentive to the safety of all Great Escape participants.
8. Provide information to parents at drop off and pick up times (as needed).
