



## Great Escape Assistant Camp Counselor Job Description

**Goal:** To assist camp counselors in planning and implementing summer activities for school-aged children (pre K-7<sup>th</sup> grade), which encourage the Great Escape goals of faith development, peer relationship building, physical activity, and creativity.

### **Job Requirements:**

1. Personable, with a heart for children.
2. Ability to be a leader of children.
3. Ability to share faith lessons in daily activities.
4. Must be going into Junior year of high school, or older.

### **Responsibilities:**

1. Assist camp counselors with leadership of daily activities, games, sports, crafts, service projects, and outings.
2. Establish personal relationships with Great Escape participants, particularly with children needing extra support, while being a leader.
3. Be respectful and help maintain the respectful conduct of all participants, at Great Escape.
4. Be attentive to the safety of all Great Escape participants.
5. Assist Great Escape staff, as directed.
6. Demonstrate faith in action, at all times.
