



Great Escape Assistant Camp Counselor Job Description

Goal: To assist camp counselors in planning and implementing summer activities for school-aged children which encourage the Great Escape goals of spiritual growth, peer relationship building, physical activity, and creative development.

Responsibilities:

1. Assist camp counselors with daily activities, games, sports, projects and outings, within your age group.
2. Establish personal relationships with the Great Escape participants, particularly with children needing extra support, while being a leader.
3. Demonstrate faith in action at all times.
4. Be respectful and help maintain the respectful conduct of all participants at Great Escape.
5. Be attentive to the safety of all Great Escape participants at all times.
6. Assist your team as needed.

Job Requirements:

1. Personable with a love for children and inventive play.
2. Experience and ability to develop relationships with children.
3. Ability to be a leader of children.
4. Ability to share faith lessons in daily activities.
5. Must be going into Junior year of high school for 2020-2021 school year or older.
