



Great Escape Camp Counselor Job Description

Goal: To be a leader of summer activities for school-aged children which encourages the Great Escape goals of spiritual growth, peer relationship building, physical activity, and creative development.

Responsibilities:

1. Lead daily activities, games, sports, projects and outings, as a part of a leadership team.
2. Establish personal relationships with the Great Escape participants, particularly with children needing extra support, while being an adult leader.
3. Provide spiritual leadership in all aspects of daily camp life and demonstrate faith in action.
4. Maintain the respectful conduct of all participants of Great Escape.
5. Be attentive to the safety of all Great Escape participants, at all times.
6. Provide information to parents at drop off and pick up times. If necessary, communicate concerns to the lead counselor.
7. Contribute ideas for activities, crafts, outings, and projects.
8. Act as a team player, assisting and supporting others on staff.
9. Be accountable to accomplish leadership and planning assignments.

Job Requirements:

1. Personable, with a love for children and inventive play.
2. Experience and ability in developing relationships with children.
3. Ability to be a leader of children.
4. Interested in creative learning and inspiring children intellectually.
5. Ability to see and share faith lessons in daily activities.
6. Have completed one year of college.

*Completing a Pediatric Medic First Aid class, online concussion training and attaining a chauffeur's license prior to orientation is required. Details provided upon hiring.
